

**Application Suggestions, November 29, 2020**  
**Meanwhile: Waiting for God's Promises**  
**2 Peter 3:1-18**

Peter challenges us to “remember”—remember God; the words of God; the works of God; and, most of all, God’s saving you.

- Take a few moments in prayerful reflection—and remember!

Peter challenges us to “look forward”—look forward to Christ’s Second Coming and consider how we should live in the “meanwhile.” Specifically, he calls us to live “spotless” and “blameless” lives.

- With those words in mind, pray the words of the Psalmist in Psalm 139:23-24 and let God answer your inquiry.

*“Search me, God, and know my heart; test me and know my anxious thoughts. See if there is any offensive way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting.”*

Peter challenges us to “grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ.”

- Review the main points of the “Meanwhile” sermon series and ask God to lead you in specific steps to help you “grow” in Christ.
