#### INSTRUCTIONS

- Pull out each card in order.
- Find the corresponding object.
- Read the instructions on the card.

### CARD 2

**OBJECT:** Leaf

**SCRIPTURE:**

**Matthew 21:1-11**

*Look up and read the Scripture passage.*

**DISCUSS**

- What do you think a **leaf** has to do with the story?
- Why were the people waving leaves and praising Jesus?
- What is one reason you can praise Jesus today?

*The **leaf** reminds us of the people praising Jesus as He rode into Jerusalem.*

*We can praise Jesus today!*

### CARD 3

**OBJECT:** Perfume

**Cotton Ball**

**SCRIPTURE:**

**Matthew 26:1-13**

*Look up and read the Scripture passage.*

**DISCUSS**

- What do you think the **perfume cotton ball** has to do with the story?
- Why was it important that the women poured perfume on Jesus?

*The **perfume** reminds us that Jesus was anointed to prepare for His death.*

*Like the women gave her precious gift, we can give Jesus the gift of our hearts.*

### CARD 4

**OBJECT:** Small Cracker

**SCRIPTURE:**

**Mark 14:12-26**

*Look up and read the Scripture passage.*

**DISCUSS**

- What do you think a **cracker** has to do with the story?
- What did the bread and the cup represent at the Last Supper?
- How can we remember the sacrifice of Jesus today?

*The **cracker** reminds us of the bread that Jesus said represented His body.*



### CARD 5

**OBJECT:** Small Cup

**SCRIPTURE:**

**Mark 14:32-41**

*Look up and read the Scripture passage.*

**DISCUSS**

- What do you think a **cup** has to do with the story?
- What did Jesus say when praying to the Father?
- Would it be easy or hard for you to say to God “Not my will, but yours be done,” when facing something difficult?

*The **cup** represents the hardship Jesus was about to face. We can thank Him for choosing to die on the cross.*

### CARD 6

**OBJECT:** Silver Beads

**SCRIPTURE:**

**Matthew 26:14-16**

**Mark 14:42-56**

*Look up and read the Scripture passages.*

**DISCUSS**

- What do you think the **silver** has to do with the story?
- How did Judas betray Jesus?
- How can you show your loyalty to Jesus today?

*The **silver** represents the silver pieces Judas accepted to bring the soldiers to Jesus to arrest Him. We can show Jesus we are loyal to Him, no matter what.*

### CARD 7

**OBJECT:** Feathers

**SCRIPTURE:**

**Matthew 26:57-75**

*Look up and read the Scripture passage.*

**DISCUSS**

- What do you think the **feathers** have to do with the story?
- Why did Peter act like he didn't know Jesus?
- How can you show others that you aren't ashamed to know Jesus?

*The **feathers** represent the rooster that crowed when Peter disowned Jesus three times. We can be bold and tell others about Jesus!*

### CARD 8

**OBJECT:** Crown

**SCRIPTURE:**

**Mark 15:1-18**

*Look up and read the Scripture passage.*

**DISCUSS**

- What do you think a **crown** has to do with the story?
- Why were the people hurting Jesus?
- How does it make you feel to think about the horrible things Jesus went through?

*The **crown** represents the crown of thorns the people put on Jesus when they were beating Him up. We can thank Jesus for enduring that pain for us.*





## CARD 9

**OBJECT:** Dice

**SCRIPTURE:**

**Matthew 27:31-36**

*Look up and read the Scripture passage.*

**DISCUSS**

- What do you think the **dice** has to do with the story?
- Did Jesus deserve to die on the cross?
- How can we always remember the sacrifice Jesus made on the cross?

*The dice represents the people dividing up Jesus' clothes as they watched Him die on the cross. We can remember the sacrifice Jesus made on the cross.*

## CARD 10

**OBJECT:** Cross

**SCRIPTURE:**

**Matthew 27:37-51**

*Look up and read the Scripture passage.*

**DISCUSS**

- What do you think a **cross** has to do with the story?
- Why did Jesus die on the cross?
- Have you asked Jesus to forgive your sins?

*The **cross** reminds us of the great sacrifice of Jesus' death. Even though He was perfect, He died for our sins. We can ask Him to forgive us and thank Him for taking the punishment for our sins.*

## CARD 11

**OBJECT:** Piece of Cloth

**SCRIPTURE:**

**Matthew 27:55-66**

*Look up and read the Scripture passage.*

**DISCUSS**

- What do you think a **piece of cloth** has to do with the story?
- Why did they make Jesus' tomb as secure as possible?
- How do you think the people felt when Jesus' body was put into the tomb?

*The **piece of cloth** represents the cloth used to wrap Jesus' body when He was buried. We can thank God that Jesus died even when He didn't deserve it.*

## CARD 12

**OBJECT:** Stone

**SCRIPTURE:**

**Matthew 27:65-66;**

**Mark 16:1-6**

*Look up and read the Scripture passage.*

**DISCUSS**

- What do you think a **stone** has to do with the story?
- Why were the women going to the tomb?
- How does it make you feel knowing Jesus is alive?

*The **stone** represents the stone that was at the entrance to the tomb. It was empty because Jesus is alive! We can praise God and celebrate!*



### CARD 13

**OBJECT:** Popper

**SCRIPTURE:**

**Matthew 28:6-11**

*Look up and read the Scripture passage.*

**DISCUSS**

- What do you think a **popper** has to do with the story?
- How do you think the women and disciples felt when they realized Jesus was alive?

*Turn the **popper** inside out and set it down. Wait for it to POP up. Jesus was buried, but He didn't stay down. He rose UP from the grave, and He lives today! We can celebrate Him today!*

### CARD 14

**OBJECT:** Globe

**SCRIPTURE:**

**Matthew 28:16-20**

*Look up and read the Scripture passage.*

**DISCUSS**

- What did Jesus tell the disciples to do?
- What did Jesus promise them?
- Who can you tell about Jesus?

*The **globe** represents all the people in the world who Jesus commanded us to share the Good News with. We can share the story of Jesus with others. This is the true meaning of Easter.*
