We are so excited to finally get everybody back in church together. It is especially great because this Sunday, May 31, 2020 is Pentecost Sunday! President Trump has declared churches “essential,” and Gov. Newsom of California, and Riverside Co have given the green light to re-open churches.

We will have *two services* at our regular times: **9:30am** and **11:00am**, with livestream available at both services. We want to welcome the Holy Spirit’s presence on Pentecost Sunday! We invite you to a time of celebration and praise!

Your safety is a top priority for us. We are following CDC, and government guidelines, to ensure the health and safety of everyone who attends.

- The sanctuary is being disinfected and sanitized with EPA approved disinfectants, along with all traffic areas including foyers and hallways before and after service.
- All toilets and handwashing facilities will be disinfected prior to, between, and after each service.
- Staff, congregants and visitors are asked to self-screen and stay at home if exhibiting any Covid-19 symptoms.
- If you are older, uncomfortable or have a compromised immune system, we will be livestreaming both services live for your safety, convenience, and edification.

When you arrive, ushers wearing masks and gloves, and equipped with hand sanitizers will greet you. We are following CDC guidelines, so masks are available to those who ask. Ushers will then direct people to accommodate social distancing. Families are permitted to sit together. No children’s ministries will be available at this time. Attendance will be limited to 100 per service in the sanctuary, which will provide more than enough room for social distancing.
