## From the Pastor ...

#### New Year - New Creation

"From now on, therefore, we regard no one according to the flesh. Even though we once regarded Christ according to the flesh, we regard Him thus no longer. Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation.

The old has passed away; behold, the new has come. All this is from God, who through Christ reconciled us to Himself and gave us the ministry of reconciliation ..." 2 Corinthians 4:16-18

It is not easy to celebrate a new year when it seems that nothing has really changed except the strain of the virus that fuels the global pandemic. Christmas has come and gone. The celebration of the new year was muted by the reality of the ongoing challenges of daily life. Little that has happened in the natural order has inspired feelings of newness. Fortunately, neither our natural feelings of great joy or sorrow determine the course of our life. We are not a new creation because we look like it or feel like it now.

The unbelieving world does not recognize what God has done in the birth of Jesus. As the children of God we have been given new life by the power of the Holy Spirit at work in Holy Baptism. Jesus joined Himself to all of humanity in the water of the Jordan River. Jesus assured John the Baptist – "Let is be so now, for thus it is fitting for us to fulfill all righteousness." (Matthew 3:15) We have been joined to Jesus in the water and the Word of the Gospel at the baptismal font. The Holy Spirit assures us through the words of the apostle Paul – "We were therefore buried with Him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life." (Romans 6:4) We are a new creation because God says so! Baptismal life calls us to daily contrition and repentance – the "drowning" of old Adam and Eve in us. We believe and trust that we emerge daily by God's grace in Christ as new men and new women in the forgiveness of our sins.

God has blessed Faith Lutheran Church to believe, teach, and practice the Confessional truth of His renewing power in the Gospel for 60 years. At the end of this month we will gather to acknowledge the gift of new life in Christ and the enduring opportunity to serve Him in the ministry of the Gospel. In faith, we reject the notion of being stuck in a dark world. In the season of Epiphany, we embrace our identity as "... a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for His own possession, that you may proclaim the excellencies of Him who called you out of the darkness into His marvelous light." (1 Peter 2:9)

God invites us to see the new things that He is doing among us. We see new people in worship. We value new opportunities to witness Christ in word and deed. We look forward to the new day in the blessed hope of life eternal in the Savior. Come celebrate the new creation with us on January 30!

## Remembering Christmas with Faith children and youth . . .




Through one tree came sin and death;
