- 1. Cain and Abel both knew about doing well.
- 2. Both knew what they were to <u>sacrifice</u> when they did not do well.
- 3. Cain thought he was <u>righteous</u> by not offering the right sacrifice, but rather sacrificed the work of his hands.
- 4. The way of Cain has two major parts:
 - a. Reject the counsel of God against you.
 - b. Murder/Persecute the righteous blood
- 5. The way of Cain would be the way for Israel's leaders throughout their <u>history</u>.
- 6. The way of Cain would be followed by the Pharisees and Sadducees.
