- 1. The tower of Babel was a <u>organize revolt</u> against God.
- 2. Three major things were manifest at the tower of Babel concerning the <u>course</u> of the world.
 - 1) They <u>disobedient</u> God's will given to Noah. (Gen. 9:1)
 - 2) They collectively went to make a <u>name</u> for themselves
 - 3) They built a city and tower whose top would reach <u>heaven</u> and engaged in <u>communing</u> with <u>heaven</u> despite God. (Idolatry)
- 3. Although God thwarted Satan's main objective, Satan's own worship by these idolators would be scattered abroad in God's judgment of division.
- 4. The course of the world was now established and the vail over all nations was laid.
- 5. The Lord Jesus Christ will one day <u>judge</u> this <u>course</u>, <u>nations</u>, and <u>Adversary</u> and his evil.
