## **Guidelines for Children's Ministry**

*Below are the temporary guidelines regarding the Children's Ministry at The Vine Church.*

Until the social distancing order has been lifted there will be no classes or childcare offered at this time for any of our Sunday services.

Your kiddo will join you in service. Worship videos will be available on the Church app. You will need to bring a device and earbuds /

headphones for your kiddo. This is just a way to give your child an opportunity to listen to their own programming. “Busy Bags” will also be available for your child in the foyer. The bags will have coloring sheets, crayons, etc. Bags are for your child to keep and do not need to be returned.

## **Guidelines for Student Ministry**

We will offer Student Ministry during the Second Service in portable 1. Your student will be encouraged to follow all the social distancing guidelines.

## **FAQ for Phase 1 Re-Gathering**

### **1. Will the service still be live-streamed?**

Yes, our livestream was going out before Covid-19 and will continue. The livestream will be at 9:30AM.

### **2. Will there be temperature checks?**

Yes, our greeters will have infrared thermometers. This is to ensure the safety of all who come to worship.

### **3. How will I be greeted?**

All of our greeters who interact with guests will be wearing gloves and masks to ensure the safety of those around them. We encourage you to let our greeters open the doors for you.

### **4. What will communion look like?**

We will be providing individually packaged communion on the back table in the auditorium.

Deacons, using gloves, will make sure there is enough communion. You will be the only person to touch your cup & bread.

**5. What will offering look like?**

We will not be passing the plate. We encourage everyone to become an online giver. If you do bring an offering on Sunday we will make the offering box available on the back table. Just drop it in.

**6. Will the coffee cart be open?**

No, not for a few weeks. “Bummer” I know.

**7. Will there be places to sanitize?**

We have added sanitizing machines to the building. The greeters will be able to point you in the right direction.

**8. Can I have physical contact with others?**

There will be no official handshaking or physical contact encouraged.

**9. Will there be a reduced number of seats in the auditorium?**

Yes, we will be limiting our seating capacity in an effort to create the space needed to effectively social distance. Once we are at capacity we will, unfortunately, have to turn people away.

**10. Is there a plan in place to clean/sanitize in between Sunday Services?**

Yes, in between services our deacons and staff will be disinfecting all surfaces in the auditorium and bathrooms.
