Pray

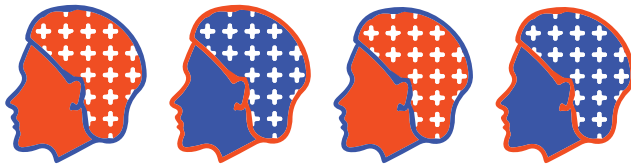
