

## PRAY

# TAWG DAY 20

## WORSHIP

Get creative! Sing, paint, write a poem, play an instrument, photograph nature, map out a timeline of your relationship with God, etc. If you don't know what to do, jam to a few of the worship songs from camp (like Mosaic MSC's "Unknown"). Whatever you do, just allow your mind's attention and your heart's affection to be centered on The Creator Himself.

## READ & PROCESS

Read Daniel 6

- How did the administrators & high officers perceive Daniel?
- What did Daniel do to earn their accusations?
- How did King Darius feel about throwing Daniel to the lions?
- What does King Darius decree at the end of the chapter?

Daniel lived righteously, and because of this, many people liked Daniel; however, there were a few who despised him. Living as Christians today, we face the possibility of being ridiculed or discriminated by those who feel threatened by our holy lifestyle. We are called to be set apart, and we must stay true to Him, regardless of the consequences. When we stay true to our faith, miraculous things may happen & Jesus's name will be made KNOWN. Have you ever been mocked or ridiculed for your beliefs? How should you deal with this in the future?

## PRAY

Pray for your school, your work, and any other environments that might not accept Christianity. If you're feeling adventurous, walk around the community and pray for these places.

# TAWG DAY 19

## PRAY

If you've been faithfully completing this devotional, today marks two weeks since the return of camp. Pray for your cabin today, and maybe even shoot them a text of encouragement.

*"Let us think of ways to motivate one another to acts of love and good works. And let us not neglect our meeting together, as some people do, but encourage one another, especially now that the day of his return is drawing near."*

*Hebrews 10:24-25*

## READ & PROCESS

Read Daniel 5

- How does King Belshazzar respond to the writing on the wall?
- Reread verses 18-23. Who does Daniel compare King Belshazzar to? How is King Belshazzar similar to this individual?
- What is King Belshazzar's fate?

King Belshazzar had a lot of pride and a deadly fear of the UNKNOWN. He looked everywhere for answers about the writing on the wall, yet, because of his ego, never looked to God. Are there any UNKNOWN circumstances in your life where you need to stop asking the world for advice and seek out God's guidance and provision instead?

## PRAY

The largest UNKNOWN in my life is the future. I know it's easy to ignore what God has to say & plan things on our own. Today, surrender your own desires & ask God to reveal a glimpse of His plan for your life.

# TAWG DAY 18

## PRAY

Often, our prayers only consist of asking God for things. Prayer is a conversation with God, and conversations are supposed to be two-sided. God wants to speak to us too. Today, pray like this:

*Father, clear my mind of anything that is not of You. Quiet my anxious and racing thoughts. I want to hear from You.*

## READ & PROCESS

Read Daniel 4

- Pay attention to verse 27. Daniel is trying to keep Nebuchadnezzar accountable for his pride. Who are individuals that keep you accountable?
- What does Nebuchadnezzar do that results in his banishment?
- After spending time in the UNKNOWN, what does Nebuchadnezzar do?

It took banishment to the UNKNOWN for Nebuchadnezzar to admit God's greatness. Even though Nebuchadnezzar didn't understand these circumstances, they ultimately grew his relationship with the Lord.

Has there ever been a situation that you didn't understand? How did God use this situation for the advancement of His Kingdom?

## PRAY

*Lord, thank you for gifting me with individuals & situations that will make me better. Even if I may not understand these things right now, I know that Your plan is good & that You have my best interests at heart.*

## LISTEN & PRAY

Today, listen to Hillsong United's "So Will I". Let the lyrics sink in, and process what they mean for your life. Pray for a strong faith even amidst the "great UNKNOWN".

## READ & PROCESS

Read Daniel 3

We've all probably heard the story of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego. It's a story of 3 friends who have a faith so strong that they would rather risk death than worship any god except their own. We should consider this story keeping in mind these 5 words:

**PERSUADED** - Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego were fully convinced of God's promises and their obedience to him.

**PRESSURE** - Even though Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego were *persuaded* that God would save them, the fire grew hotter than ever.

**PROMISE** - Read Isaiah 43:1-2. God never promises to extinguish the fire, but he does promise to walk through it with you.

**PROTECTION** - Though the flames destroyed the soldiers, God helped Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego break free from their shackles and survive the heat.

**PROMOTION** - The fire may have been their greatest test, but Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego got promoted because Nebuchadnezzar had seen God's goodness and favor for them.

## PRAY

Pray like Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego:

*God, I know You are able to rescue me from this fire, but even if You don't, I will not bow down to other things. When the pressure rises, help me to be fully persuaded and trust in Your promises.*

# TAWG DAY 16

## **PRAY**

Before you dive in today, pull out your phone and scroll through your contacts. Who is the Lord laying on your heart? Type out your prayer for him/her (*don't just say, "Hey! I prayed for you today!"*). Then, send it as a text.

## **READ & PROCESS**

Read Daniel 2

- How does Daniel respond when he hears about Nebuchadnezzar's order to execute all the wise men of Babylon?
- How does Daniel respond when God reveals the secret?
- Reread verses 27-30. What is the first thing Daniel tells Nebuchadnezzar?
- How does Nebuchadnezzar respond to Daniel's interpretation?

Amidst the UNKNOWN, Daniel humbled himself & glorified God. Because of Daniel's faithfulness & obedience, Nebuchadnezzar came to recognize God's sovereignty and even rewarded Daniel with many valuable gifts.

Are there areas in your life where you need to acknowledge God's great power?

## **PRAY**

Take a moment to reflect on things that God has done in your life. Thank Him for these things through prayer and praise.

## PRAY

Use the following guide:

**PRAISE:** *Spend time praising God for who He is.  
(God, You are my King. You are good to me.)*

**ADMIT:** *Spend time admitting your faults/shortcomings to God.  
Get right with Him.*

**YIELD:** *Spend time surrendering yourself to God's love and will.  
Ask Him to take control of everything.*

## READ & PROCESS

Read Daniel 1

Imagine that your city has just been captured by the enemy. Everything you once knew—even your identity—is gone. Everything is strange, new, and UNKNOWN. It would be very easy to lower your standards and blend in to scrape by and survive.

Daniel, on the other hand, remained strong and faithful. He didn't blend in. In fact, he stood out and got promoted!

- Describe a time when you have been tempted to compromise your beliefs in order to fit in?
- Is there a certain friend or environment that causes you to compromise your beliefs more than others? How are you able to stand out and remain faithful during these situations?


## PRAY

*Lord, give me a holy boldness. When the world seems against me, help me to stand firm in my faith and not compromise my beliefs. Help me to stand out and be a light to the darkness.*

Read Luke 9:57-62 and then reread the passage

- Essentially Jesus is asking this man to leave the comfort of having a home, leave current realities with the death of a family member and to leave family in general without even saying goodbye. Would you be willing to do this?
- Jesus calls for radical obedience, does this accurately describe your relationship with Jesus? What needs changed?

Purchase one of these books and read it as a guide on how to be more radical with your faith.



# TAWG DAY 13

## **PRAY**

Get up and go outside! Take a prayer walk through your neighborhood, town or in nature. As you walk, simply observe your surroundings. Praise God. Seek God. Pray for people or places you see. Pray for wisdom to be a good neighbor to people. Take in the sights, smells, sounds, and textures around you. In the end have the ultimate goal to appreciate the sensation of being alive.

## **READ & PROCESS**

Read the entire book of Jonah (it won't take you long...it is short)

- Why does Jonah run from God? What are his motivations for disobedience? Do you blame him?
- How does God respond to Jonah's disobedience?
- Why is Jonah upset with God for having mercy on Nineveh?
- What is the personal take away for you from the story of Jonah?

## **JOURNAL**

- What is happening in your world right now?  
-The Good, The Bad, and The Ugly
- How's your heart? (In relationship to Jesus)
- What are the areas of your life that you need God to intervene in right now?
- Who is someone in your life that would benefit from you reaching out and checking on them?

## READ & PROCESS

God, the blessed and only Ruler, the King of kings and Lord of lords, who alone is immortal and who lives in unapproachable light, whom no one has seen or can see. To him be honor and might forever. Amen. -1 Timothy 6:15-16

Read Revelation 4

- Describe the images that you visualized when reading these passages.
- Do you have a hard time fully grasping who God is and what heaven will be like? Write down the questions you have.
- What are your thoughts on heaven? Press into the UNKNOWN of eternity.

## DRAW/PAINT

Draw a picture using the imagery from above. As you draw or paint, keep thinking about the power and mystery of God and heaven.

## PRAY

Shout the praises of God. Acknowledge His greatness. Name His power and His attributes. Praise your King.

What title did she give to God? \_\_\_\_\_


## MEDITATION



- Do you think John ever doubted whether God was going to send His son? Day after day preach and baptizing with lot of unknowns?

## JOURNAL

What God-given mission are you wondering whether it's even worth it? What or who are you tempted to give up on?

# TAWG DAY 10

## PRAY

Prayer is more about being than speaking.

Read Matthew 14:22-33. In a minute close your eyes and imagine yourself being present at the scene. Imagine the feeling of being on a boat, the strong wind, the waves hitting the boat, the mist on your face. Picture the darkness, the tiredness that settles in the middle of the night. Then imagine seeing Jesus, fully human, walking on the surface of the water, his feet hitting the wetness of the water with every step. Now place yourself in Peter's shoes and imagine Jesus calling you out into the UNKNOWN of the waters. Picture the emotion and feeling of that first step on the water without sinking. Imagine the sinking moment and feeling Jesus's rough, firm grip as extends his hand to save you. Look into Jesus's eyes. What do you see?

## LISTEN

Take a moment to listen to the song OCEANS by Hillsong United. As you listen keep experiencing the moment you just had of being in the presence of Jesus.

## READ & PROCESS

Read Matthew 14:22-33

- Why did Jesus walk on the water in front of His disciples? What was the purpose of this?
- If you were Peter would you leave the safety of the boat to walk to Jesus? Doing the impossible?
- What water is Jesus asking you to step out onto in faith?

## PRAY

Pray for boldness. Ask Jesus to call you out on the waters. Ask Him to show you what the waters are.

Teach me how to be compassionate to the suffering,

and needed an angel to console you.  
Above all, I want to learn

## READ & PROCESS

Read Matthew 9:9-13

- How did Matthew respond to Jesus's invitation to follow?
- Matthew did not know where He was following Jesus, there were a LOT of UNKNOWNs. Imagine being Matthew and just getting up and leaving everything behind to follow Jesus.
- Who did Jesus say he came for? Who are the sinners? Are you one of those sinners? (The answer is yes)
- Do you follow Jesus and sit with "sinners?" Do you build relationships with "sinners?"

# TAWG DAY 8

## **PRAY**

Pull up a map of your city on your phone or even better print a picture off your computer. Then mark on your map/pray for these places:

1. Your House
2. Your Neighborhood
3. Schools
4. Police
5. Mayor
6. Friends' houses

## **MEDITATE**

Breathe in deeply 3X. Sit up straight and do everything you can to not move. Close your eyes. Breathe deeply 3X. Picture approaching God's throne in heaven. Imagine being face to face with Jesus. Don't say anything, just be still in His presence. Feel His goodness. Experience His peace. Allow His love to fill you up.


## **READ & PROCESS**

Read Acts 9:1-31

- Why would God choose to use Saul as his agent to spread the Gospel?
- Who had the harder job, Saul or Ananias?
- Spend a moment and imagine being Saul... you have a supernatural encounter with God, go blind for three days and then meet a random guy, and get baptized to do the work of God.

## **PRAY**

Ask that God would fill you with the Holy Spirit like He did with Paul, so many years ago.



# TAWG DAY 4

## THE WARFARE PRAYER

Pray the prayer of Thomas Merton to begin your TAWG.

My Lord God,  
I have no idea where I am going.  
I do not see the road ahead of me.  
I cannot know for certain where it will end,  
nor do I really know myself,  
and the fact that I think I am following your will  
does not mean that I am actually doing so.  
But I believe that the desire to please you  
does in fact please you.  
And I hope I have that desire in all that I am doing.  
I hope that I will never do anything apart from that desire.  
And I know that if I do this you will lead me by the right road,  
though I may know nothing about it.  
Therefore will I trust you always though  
I may seem to be lost and in the shadow of death.  
I will not fear, for you are ever with me,  
and you will never leave me to face my perils alone.

## READ ACTS 13:1-4, 16:1-10, and 20:17-24

All three texts share parts of Paul's missionary journey. If you have extra time read more about his journeys and what took place. It is powerful stuff! In all three stories Paul is heading into UNKNOWN territory. These are foreign places, cultures, and people. As Paul takes off, imagine/write down what are the unknowns he is stepping into (Ex. Languages or where he will sleep) :

# TAWG DAY 7

## PRAY

### **THE SERENITY PRAYER**

God grant me the serenity to accept the things I cannot change;  
courage to change the things I can;  
And wisdom to know the difference.  
Living one day at a time;  
Enjoying one moment at a time;  
Accepting hardships as the pathway to peace;  
Taking as He did, this sinful world as it is, not as I would have it;  
Trusting that He will make all things right if I surrender to His Will;  
That I may be reasonably happy in this life and supremely happy  
with Him forever in the next. **AMEN**

## READ & PROCESS

Read 1 Samuel 16

- How do you think Samuel felt when God called him to anoint a new king, while Saul was still king? Feel the emotions.
- What is God's response to Jesse's first son Eliab?
- How do you think David felt heading into the UNKNOWN of the future? Anointed for kingship and then sent into the service of the king he was to replace.

## REFLECT

What is God calling you to, that may be uncomfortable or down right scary?

What is the key in 1 Samuel 16 to take on the UNKNOWN? (hint is in verse 13)

# TAWG DAY 6

Welcome back home! Over these next few weeks, stay strong in your TAWG, create the good habit! You can do this! We encourage you to purchase or use a journal you already have as we condense each day to one page.

**LISTEN**

Play some of the worship songs we sang at camp, especially Mosaic MSC's "Unknown." As you listen, allow the words to sink in and process what they mean for your life.

**PRAY**

Spend time asking God to continue to meet with you like He did at camp. Invite the Holy Spirit into your TAWG and ask Him to illuminate the Word today.

**READ & PROCESS**

Read Exodus Chapter 3

- What is God calling Moses to?
- What does God say in response to Moses' question in verse 11?
- Put yourself in Moses' shoes, how would you respond to God calling you into the UNKNOWN?

God showed Moses a people group that was afflicted and called him into action. Is there an afflicted person or people group that God is calling you to help?

**PRAY FOR THE UNDERDOG**

Pray for those in your school that are "outcasts" or mistreated. Pray for refugees. Pray for those caught in human trafficking. Pray for orphans and widows.

In all three passages, who is guiding Paul?

**JOURNAL**

Do you allow the Holy Spirit to guide you in all areas of your life? Or do you dictate what happens in your life, where you go, what you do, etc.? Put the categories in the box on the chart below.

**PRAYER**


## **REFLECTION TIME**
