



10 Questions About Outdoor Church

Do I have to be in contact with anyone if I don't want to even roll my windows down?

You do not have to be in any contact if you prefer it that way. [All you need to do is download the "No Contact" PDF here to print.](#) You can put that in your car window, so we know you are not rolling your window down. Make sure you check the app when you arrive to see any instructions we have for that service, and we encourage you to bring your own communion. Keep that sign in your window throughout the service, and you will be totally free from any contact!

Will the sound quality be good if I'm in my car OR if I'm sitting outside?

We have the service streaming straight to the radio station 88.5 FM for people staying in their car, and we also have speakers outside for people wanting to sit outside their car in their designated parking spot. Both options will give you a quality sound experience!

My kids are young and might be loud and embarrassing. Will I embarrass myself and distract everyone around me?

We have great news for you. We want you to come! Church is for all ages! If you need to walk around a little bit, that's not a problem. You are also welcome to stay in your car instead of getting out. It's really up to you, but please know we welcome you, your children, and their energy.

I know I can't sit in a car that long without needing the restroom. What will I do then?

You will have 2 options. If you would like to use the church's facilities, you can walk inside the door, wearing a mask, and follow instructions on sanitizing the room after use or you can leave the service early. We have people doing both, and we understand the struggle!

What can I expect from the moment I pull on the parking lot until I leave at the end?

Will I be missing out on the sermon online if I come to OUTDOOR church?

We are doing the exact same sermon online as we are doing at the Outdoor Church service. You won't be missing anything.
