Middle Adult Fellowship: Will be Saturday, July 27 at Bama Bucks Restaurant for lunch. Details to come.

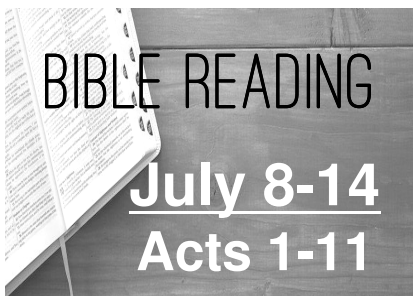
