Icebreaker: If you were a milk, what milk would you be and why (examples include: 2% milk, oat milk, chocolate milk and leftover cereal milk)?

Read Acts 11:19-26

What do these verses say about God/humanity? Is there anything that stood out to you from Justin's message on Sunday?

Justin challenged us to write down our five most spiritually impactful moments in our lives. Share one of those moments in your Life Group.

Justin also mentioned that our most spiritually important moments in life involve a community that believes in us more than we believe in ourselves and/or a step of faith where God has to show up. How have you experienced this truth in your personal walk with Jesus?

Acts 11 focused on two characters: Barnabas and Paul.

- Barnabas sees things in Paul before Paul sees them in himself.
- Barnabas pursues Paul.
- Barnabas platforms Paul over platforming himself.

For you personally, how could you start being a Barnabas to people around you starting this week?

Justin said, "In order to have Barnabas like people, we need to be Barnabas people for others." How is this encouraging and challenging for us?

- Paul goes someplace scary and uncomfortable.
- Paul persists in his step of faith.
- Paul's whole life changes because of this step of faith.

In what ways do you relate to Paul in stepping out in faith? Or, in what ways has the Spirit prompted you to step out in faith recently?
