





## Tense

- Present – current, continuous, durative, no reference to beginning 
  - *I study Greek, am studying Greek*
- Perfect – completed with ongoing results 
  - *I have studied Greek*
- Imperfect – past but continuous 
  - *I was studying Greek*
- Future – future but undefined 
  - *I will study Greek*
- Aorist – undefined, usually past (•)
  - *I studied Greek*

## Voice

- Active – subject performs action – *I give*
- Passive – subject receives the action – *I was given*
- Middle – subject performs and receives the action – *I gave myself*

## Mood

- Indicative – what is... *Jesus died for our sins*
- Imperative – what should be... *Go into all the world*
- Subjunctive – what might/could be... *and to the Jews I became as a Jew, that I **might** win Jews*
