

## What we are doing to maintain safety

- All attendees and volunteers are to maintain appropriate distances (2 metres between family groups) while entering, exiting and participating in church activities.
  - Hand sanitizer will be available at all entrances.
  - We recommend the use of masks, which will be available at all entrances.
  - There will be no congregational singing, but you are welcome to hum along.
  - We will continue to sanitize surfaces prior to each worship service.
  - Please refrain from handshakes, hugging, etc., as difficult as it may be.
  - We will not be handing out an order of service. You will continue to receive an email with the order of service, so you may follow on your phone or print off for your personal use.
  - At the conclusion of the service please exit through the door you entered, maintaining appropriate distancing.
  - A time of fellowship after the service will happen outside, weather permitting.

## Seating

We can worship in our sanctuary with a maximum of 90 people (30% of capacity), based on Phase III and Phase IV, as set out by the Province of Manitoba, July 24, 2020, effective July 27, 2020. Upon entering the church building, you will be directed to available seating closest to the entrance you enter.

- Rows not available will be clearly marked. For every pew available the next two pews directly in front will not be available. Please maintain 2 metres distance between people not part of your family within the pew.

## Giving

- There will not be a time for offering during the service, however there will be a clearly marked receptacle for you to place your offering upon arrival at each entrance.
