FINANCIAL MATTERS

We are thankful for your prayerful consideration in the Excel in the Grace of Giving stewardship program for 2022. Faithful stewards returned 36 commitment cards, of which 33 monetary pledges have been made. With the submittal of these commitments, we are able to deepen our trust in God, as an individual and as a congregation, as we move into planning and budgeting in 2022. We propose to have the 2021 year-end giving statements emailed/mailed out to you by mid-January 2022.

This will go into our General Fund and to date, we have received \$600 earmarked for this tally. At our Congregational Meeting on Dec. 19, members approved the heating addition to our current HVAC system for the sanctuary (cost \$11,650) - anticipate that installation in Feb 2022.






UPCOMING EVENTS
