- Characteristics of a Temple: (1) Place where God and man can dwell together, and (2) after the Fall, the place where sacrifice is made.
- Series of Temples: Eden, Tabernacle, Jerusalem Temple Jesus

Because (1) God and man dwell perfectly in the Person of Jesus, and (2) because of the perfection of Jesus' sacrifice, Jesus perfects what the previous temples merely foreshadowed.

"Without the cornerstone which is Christ, I do not see how men can be built into a house of God, to contain God dwelling in them..." - Augustine, *Letters 187.31*

• Church as the Temple: (1) Christians are those in whom God dwells (1 Cor. 6:19); (2) the church is called to offer "spiritual sacrifices." (1 Pet. 2:5)
