Luke 19:41-44

My desire this morning is to encourage us in the gospel. Today marks the beginning of Passion week and the Scriptures record for us the final days in the life of the Lord Jesus Christ. Jesus is making his way to the cross of Calvary. He enters the Holy City, Jerusalem and is praised as King. The crowds were praising God with a loud voice saying, "Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord! Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!" Luke is the only gospel writer who provides for us a clear and direct view into the mood of Jesus during this time. It is here that we focus our hearts' attention, and we see three truths from this text.
