The Sword of Sacred Scripture

Hebrews 4:12-13

This morning, we continue our study of Hebrews chapter four by examining verses twelve and thirteen. At first glance, we might think these verses are out of place, when in reality they are a continuation of the exhortation to "enter into rest".

As we have discovered, it is only those that have faith, those that believe, which enter into God's rest. The question would naturally arise, where does this "resting faith" come from?

Those who experience rest are those that trust God's Word. (12) The author transitions us to a brief declaration concerning the operation and effectiveness of the Scriptures. We will never experience rest if we disregard God and his Word.

- o **It is living.** It is not a musty old relic of the past; it is living and life-giving.
- It is powerful. This Greek word is where we get the word "energy". It speaks of operative or effectual power.
- o **It is penetrating.** Sharper than a two-edged sword, like a surgeon scalpel cutting in order to heal and restore.
- o It is discerning. The Bible is the only book that when you read it, it reads you!

Like a mirror revealing our external condition, the Word of God reveals much more. It looks within and reveals the secret, hidden intents of our hearts!
