John 1:29-34
He is Here

1. He is the Lamb of God (John 1:29)
 - a. The theme of the Lamb of God*
 1. Lamb of God typified in Genesis 4
 2. Lamb of God prophesied in Genesis 22
 3. Lamb of God slain in Exodus 12
 4. Lamb of God personified in Isaiah 53
 5. Lamb of God identified in John 1:29
 6. Lamb of God magnified in Revelation 5
 7. Lamb of God glorified in Revelation 22

b. He takes away sins (Ex 29:39; Numbers 28; 2 Kings 16; 1 Peter 2:24; Psalm 103:3)

c. The extent of the atonement (Matt 1:21; John 17:6; John 5:24; John 6:40; Acts 10:43; Acts 13:48; 1 John 2:2; 1 Tim 2:6; Hebrews 2:9; 1 John 4:14)

2. He is the Pre-existent Christ (John 1:30-31)

a. Jesus is human and divine (John 1:30)

b. Jesus was being revealed by God through John (John 1:31)

3. He is the one who baptizes with the Holy Spirit (John 1:32-33)

a. The coming of the Spirit on Jesus inaugurated the public ministry of Christ (John 1:32)

b. What does it mean to be baptized by the Holy Spirit (John 1:33)?

4. He is the Son of God (John 1:34)

a. The OT affirms Jesus as the Son God (Psalm 2:7)

b. Jesus affirms that He is the Son of God (Matt 3:17)

c. God the Father affirms that Jesus is the Son of God (Matt 3:17)

d. Others affirmed that Jesus is the Son of God (Matt 14:33)

e. Demons affirm that Jesus is the Son of God (Mark 5:7)

f. John the Baptist affirms that Jesus is the Son of God (John 1:34)
