Go Get It Back

Genesis 14:11-16

NOTES INTRODUCTION Are you missing something you once had? It could be a physical possession, an emotion, a connection, or any number of things. God does not intend for you to lose the things you need the most. He is a loving God who wants the best for you. In today's key passage, we see what happens when Abram is robbed, and how he goes to take back what is rightfully his. We can do the same with God's help. In this sermon, we're going to take a look at how exactly we can take back what is rightfully ours with the help of the Holy Spirit inside of us guiding us and instructing us along the way. **KEY POINTS** 1. You must determine that what you lost is worth fighting for. Abram knew that Lot was part of the promise God had given him. As a believer, you have probably received a promise from God. If not already, at some point, you will come to a place where you will depend on God, and He will come through with a promise. However, God might allow the devil to test you by temporarily taking what was promised. Or maybe you have yet to receive that promise and circumstances seem as if it will never happen. No matter what the situation or circumstance appears to be, like Abram, you cannot give up. Proverbs 30:5 says, "Every word of God is flawless; he is a shield to those who take refuge in him." If God promised you something, He will deliver. It does not matter if that seems next to impossible in this moment. But God might require something of you, and that is for you to keep fighting for whatever it is God has in store for you. Trust me my friend, if God promised it, it's a promise worth fighting for. 2. You must realize you need help to fight. What is interesting about the story of Abram pursuing Lot in Genesis 14 is that when Abram lost his nephew, he didn't fight back alone. He had people around him to back him up. God had uniquely designed and positioned warriors and fighters to go with him in battle to get Lot back. That is good news because it lets us know that if you trust God, He will back you up when you go into battle.

These warriors represent the huge army of people we need and whom God will position in our lives to intervene and intercede on our behalf when things start to go astray. This can be prayer warriors, intercessors, encouragers, or people who know the Word.	NOTES
Whatever it is you are going through, you do not have to go at it alone. Find your army. Allow God to bring others into your life who will help you. God will move heaven and earth to make His plan happen in your life. Your job is simply to be obedient and allow Him to do so. So allow God to give you an army that is there when you need them most.	
3. You must use the right strategy to fight. Our God is not a God of chance. He is a God of intention, a God with a plan, and therefore if we want His best for us and to gain back what we lost, we need to follow His lead and develop a strategy with His help. If we aren't moving forward with intentionality, we're not just going to accidentally get back what we lost. Abram went into his fight with a strategy and a plan, and we need to do the same.	
So listen to the wise people around you. Dive into the Word of God. Spend time in prayer seeking wisdom from the Holy Spirit. Ask the Lord to give you guidance and direction as you develop your plan. And as you begin to work on this strategy, you will see the Lord point you in the right direction so that you can start taking steps towards regaining what you lost.
