DISCIPLESHIP HOUSE PLAN

Years ago, our church leadership team had been trying to think of a systematic way to move people from an introduction to our church, through the basics of Christianity, to becoming diligent disciples, and eventually becoming well-trained leaders, capable of ministering to others. I had written a lot of material with these goals in mind that people could study on their own, but we weren't sure how to present it. At the time, we were meeting in an old three-story Victorian house, complete with an ornate porch, formal entryway, and various rooms that people liked to explore. Someone on the team had noted that the material was kind of laid out like a house; it had introductory material like the porch, and foundation material that acted like the big stones that supported this large structure, and lots of subjects we wanted people to explore, where we could move people from room to room, floor to floor, with each one containing the various topics we wanted them to study. I quickly drew a blueprint of a house and filled each room with the study material I had been writing. Immediately, we could see it. The design was both simple and systematic. We decided to call it Discipleship House.

It is our goal to teach this material live on Sunday nights throughout the year, record it, and present it along with study notes to anyone who is eager to be trained and equipped for ministry.

We also decided that before anyone would be invited to hold a key position in our church, they would need to go through the material on The Porch and Foundation, along with the first four rooms of the Discipleship House. After that, they could study any subject they were interested in. We felt this process would be invaluable in helping people understand our values and vision, which we feel is vital before assuming any position of leadership in our church.

What follows is a brief description of the various parts of Discipleship House and a listing of the courses available in each of the rooms. This is a work in progress and is subject to change.

THE PORCH - WELCOME TO OUR CHURCH

This introductory information is for anyone interested in learning more about our church. 


