What is *Core Four* anyway?

As Jesus led his followers and prepared for his earthly departure, he focused in on three key guys: Peter, James, and John. Together, Jesus challenged them in their faith and prepared them to further build His church and make disciples. Though He led thousands, Jesus invested his most important ministry moments into these few core guys. Core Four exists to do the same.

CF groups are same gender small groups of 3-5 people, including the leader. These groups are closed groups, that agree to meet together for 12 months of intentional growth. The purpose of CF is to lead people to learn to obey all that Jesus has commanded, and train them to do the work of the ministry. For an entire year, the CF group will meet weekly for discipleship, accountability, and preparation to create more groups at the completion of 12 months.
