

Let's be **SMART** as we plan to reopen church!

Social Distancing:

- We are using both our Sanctuary and ROC for both worship services at 9:00 and 10:45 a.m. There will be live worship music in both venues and the sermon will be live streamed from the Sanctuary into the ROC. Chairs in both venues are set up in groups of 2, 3, 4, and 5 to accommodate families of different sizes. The chair groups in the Sanctuary are six feet apart and the ones in the ROC are seven feet apart. **Please don't change the chair setup or remove any materials used to mark the areas.**
- We are striving for a "no contact" environment. Please don't shake hands, hug, high five, etc.
- Please strive to maintain a safe six foot distance from others while you move throughout our buildings.
- Hand sanitizer is available in wall mounted units in several locations. Please feel free to bring and use your own sanitizer.
- We are discouraging restroom use while at church unless you really need to go. If possible, please use your restroom at home before leaving for church and after you return home.
- For the first few weeks, our worship services will be family oriented, with no childcare provided. Please feel free to bring whatever electronic devices (with headphones) or other items for your child to use.
- Entry doors will be either propped open or opened by greeters.
- Secure offering boxes have been placed at key exit points in our Sanctuary, as well as ROC hallways and ROC lobby. Please place your offering in those. We will not be passing the offering plates during the worship services.
- Coffee service will not be provided during the first few weeks.

Masks:

- We are encouraging the use of facial masks for all those that attend. This is being encouraged for not only your personal protection, but to protect others that are attending. Statistics tell us that many who have Covid-19 are asymptomatic, meaning they do not show any symptoms at all.
- Please bring your own facial masks to wear. If you don't have one, the church has purchased a limited supply that will be available.

All Precautions:

- If you don't feel well, are sick, or running a fever, please stay at home.
- Those that are in a higher risk category due to age or medical condition, please don't feel pressured to attend. We will continue to live stream our worship services online.
- Between services, we are recruiting a volunteer team to clean and sanitize all door handles, hard surfaces, counter tops, and restrooms.

Registration for Services:

- Registration to attend our worship services is required at this time so that we can stay within our social distancing requirements. None of our church staff or leaders want to be in a position of having to turn people away from a worship service because all seating is filled.
- Registration will be available online on our church web page, as well as our church app.
- Registration will be first come, first served basis for each worship service. Once a service is filled, you will not be able to register for that specific service.
- If we do reach a point where both worship service times are filled, we will add an additional service.
- Online registration is preferred. If you are unable to register online, please call our church office no later than Thursday (12:00 noon) preceding each Sunday.
- If you register for a service and are unable to attend, please notify the church office so that the space can be opened for others.
- We encourage you to park your vehicle in the parking lot nearest the venue you will be attending. The ROC venue will hold more people than the Sanctuary, however, the Sanctuary main parking lot will hold more vehicles. If the ROC lot is full, please park in the main parking area.
