MISSION:

To develop leaders by challenging students to grow in their relationship with Jesus, and to train and equip them to share the Gospel with children in their communities.

Dear Parents,

It is exciting that another year of CYIA is in the works. I am thankful for your possible involvement in our summer ministry. Each year, slight changes are made in order to strengthen and uphold a high standard of training and discipleship for each student. Please read the outlined changes below:

- A limited number of applicants will be able to attend CYIA 2022. Space at Twin Lakes plays into this decision, but also the need to have a three to one staff to student ratio. This enables each student to have a positive experience. Staffing has not been a problem in the past, but we wanted to encourage you to apply early. *Submitting an application does not guarantee acceptance into CYIA.*
- The application deadline is: April 15. This year the cost of CYIA has increased to \$300/student. A \$25 discount is given to siblings after one full price registration. Scholarships are available. CEF encourages students to send out support letters (*provided by CEF to help cover the cost*). I never want money to be the reason a student cannot attend. Please reach out if this is an issue for you. Applications turned in after April 15th, will cost \$350 and may not be accepted.
- **First year students** who apply and a parent will need to attend a 30 minute interview before their application can be accepted. After submitting an application a member from CEF staff will contact you to set up a time for your interview.
- Due to a high number of applicants and the need for maturity in clubs, we will be primarily accepting students ages 13-18.

As always, our mission, commitment to your student(s), and desire to see children reached with the gospel remains the same. Thank you for your support of this work. We appreciate your support as we seek to lead this ministry.
