



**“When Does Life Begin?”
Psalm 139:13-16**

*Psalm 139:13-16 – “For you formed my inward parts; you knitted me together in my mother’s womb. **14** I praise you, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made. Wonderful are your works; my soul knows it very well. **15** My frame was not hidden from you, when I was being made in secret, intricately woven in the depths of the earth. **16** Your eyes saw my unformed substance; in your book were written, every one of them, the days that were formed for me, when as yet there was none of them.”*

Five reasons we should affirm the sanctity of human life in the womb:

1. God owns everything he creates.

Verse 13 – “For you formed my inward parts...”

The Hebrew verb *qanah* means to buy or purchase. As Creator, God possesses the right of ownership over everything he creates (Rom 9:20-21). Since he is the giver of life, he is the only one who has authority to take life. We do not have a right to take innocent life.

2. Every child is a magnificent creation.

In verses 13-16, David credits God with creating three things:

- “unformed substance” = embryo
- “frame” = skeleton
- “inward parts” = internal organs

The miraculous process of development in the womb:

- Conception – a unique living human being is formed
- 24 hours – a single cell begins to divide and multiply
- 22 days – a heart begins to beat
- 32 days – arms and hands are developing
- 40 days – brain waves are measurable
- 42 days – vertebrae begins to form
- Week 8 – babies can feel
- Week 11 – babies can smile and frown
- Week 13 – babies can respond to light and sound
- Week 17 – babies can dream

3. A mother instinctively loves and protects her child.

Verse 15 – “...when I was being made in secret...” (the word means a covering or shelter, a hiding place; cf. 1Sam 19:2; Ps 32:7).

4. Every child has a unique purpose.

Verse 16 – “...in your book were written, every one of them, the days that were formed for me, when as yet there was none of them.”

God has a plan and a purpose for each child’s life even before the child is born (cf. Jer 1:5, 29:11).

5. God created us for worship!

Verse 14 – “I praise you, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made. Wonderful are your works; my soul knows it very well.”
