

Crosswalk Church Redlands Policy for Coronavirus Disease-2019 During the Public Health Emergency

**Immediately in Effect Guidance for any events sponsored by
Crosswalk Church Redlands. This includes, but is not
limited to, events at 10421 Corporate Drive in Redlands,
California and 130 Tennessee Street in Redlands, California.**

Document issued on the web on OCTOBER 15, 2020.

1. Per COVID-19 INDUSTRY GUIDANCE: Places of Worship and Providers of Religious Services and Cultural Ceremonies, all staff, volunteers, or participants attending a Crosswalk Church event within San Bernardino County limits shall follow all safety and health guidance provided here within, including:

- a. Use of face coverings at all times, with the sole exceptions being in a medical emergency. Face coverings are limited to:
 - i. Cloth masks
 - ii. Surgical mask (also referred to as medical face mask)
 - iii. Bandanas
 - iv. N series masks, including:
 - I. N93, N95, N100
 - v. Any multilayer material which covers both the nose and mouth while maintaining a reasonable seal to the face.
- b. A face shield without a drape attached to the bottom edge does not qualify as a suitable face covering alternative.
 - i. Those with medical conditions which require a non-restrictive alternative are recommended to avoid larger gatherings altogether and are asked to avoid situations of volunteer or leadership to avoid potentially dangerous health situations.

- c. All staff, volunteers, or participants attending a Crosswalk Church event within San Bernardino County shall provide contact information and temperature at time of arrival for contact tracing purposes.
- d. All staff, volunteers, or participants attending a Crosswalk Church event within San Bernardino County shall not physically attend an event if/when the following conditions are in place:
 - i. Individual has tested positive for COVID-19 in the past two weeks.
 - ii. Individual is awaiting the results of a COVID-19 test.
 - iii. Individual is exhibiting symptoms associated with COVID-19.
- e. Control measures and screening
 - i. Temperature and/or symptom screenings will be available for all staff, employees, and participants upon arrival.

Temperature/symptom screener will avoid close contact to the extent possible.
 - I. Any person with a temperature of 100° F or more will be asked to leave.
 - ii. Staff, employees, and participants who are sick or exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19, or who have family members who are ill, should stay home.
- f. Crosswalk Church reserves the right to have any individual out of compliance with the guidelines provided on OCTOBER 15, 2020 removed from the 10421 Corporate Drive in Redlands, California, 130 Tennessee

Street in Redlands, California, or any other location at which Crosswalk Church leadership is hosting or co-hosting an event open to the public or dependent on a pre-registration process.

- i. Crosswalk Church reserves the right to have any individual who poses a perceived or legitimate threat to the safety of others removed from a paid position, volunteer position, or from attending events during the San Bernardino County Tier 1 classification, which indicates that the virus is widespread in the county — with more than seven cases per 100,000 residents or more than 8% of tests results reported positive over seven days. Individuals may also be asked to refrain from attending any in person events for any reason deemed appropriate by Crosswalk Church leadership.
