THE BOARD OF YOUTH

The Board of Youth shall consist of three (3) members.

The basic responsibilities of the board are to provide guidance, direction, counsel and assistance to the youth (primarily high school and middle school) of the congregation.

To carry out the responsibilities of the board, the Board of Youth shall:

- 1. Establish programs and activities for the youth of the congregation and see that proper supervision is provided.
- 2. Periodically review the nature, purpose and conduct of the youth organizations, programs, and activities to ensure that they provide well-rounded and spiritually uplifting opportunities.
- 3. Recruit, appoint and train Youth counselors to lead the Youth of the congregation (along with support from called staff) in their programs and activities.
- 4. Encourage the visitation of all youth of the congregation at least once yearly.
- 5. Provide oversight for any youth bank accounts, fund-raising and expenditures.
- 6. Submit annual budget request to the Fall Voters' Meeting and provide information for the same.
- 7. Annually select a chairman and secretary from among the members of the Board of Youth. The chairman shall preside at meetings, the secretary shall take accurate minutes of all meetings and submit them to the church office for publication in the Newsletter. The board chairman or his/her designee shall report the plans and activities of the board to the Church Council and Voters' Assembly.
