2 Kings 6:14, *“So one night the king of Aram/Syria sent a great army with many chariots and horses to surround the city. 15 When the servant of the man of God got up early the next morning and went outside, there were troops, horses, and chariots everywhere. “Oh, sir, what will we do now?” the young man cried to Elisha.”*

1 Corinthians 10:13, *“God will make a way of escape.”*

Often in life we feel surrounded by problems. Bad news, financial instability, relationship issues, sickness, it seems like there is no way out. In this sermon Pastor Alex Suber encourages us that we can be surrounded by problems but not be scared of our problems.

Question: Have you ever found yourself surrounded by people that had it in for you? What were your thoughts at that moment?

Whenever surrounded we start thinking what we can do. How can we defeat them? How can we escape?

Question: People escape to many things, what do you escape to; alcohol, outside relationships, pornography, or whatever?

Most of us when we see trouble, we look for a way out.

Remember, 1 Corinthians 10:13 says, “God is going to make a way of escape.”

DON'T BE AFRAID

- You can acknowledge the problem but begin to speak faith over it instead of fear.
- Focus on the solution!
- Focus on Jesus!

Surround yourself with people that will encourage you.

Question: Do you have people in your life that have been down the road you are travelling on?

CONCLUSION

- Surround yourself with people that can open your eye to see good in you.
- People that can remind you that you are not the one that is threaten, but you are the Threat.
- Surround yourself with those that can say to you, “There are more for you than against you. Fear Not!”

CALL TO ACTION

Over the week, Pray and ask God to open your spiritual eyes when you feel surrounded by the enemy. Once God shows you, receive by faith and walk in the peace and joy, of His love.
