



Next Gen Cleaning and Safety Protocols include:

Cleaning

- Every hard surface and all toys will be sanitized before each service
- Increased hygiene and cleaning protocols in Next Gen spaces before each service
- Additional hand-sanitizing stations available at check-in and in hallway areas
- Upgraded HEPA air filters to aid in air purification

Mask Policy

- All Next Gen volunteers and staff will be wearing masks
- Masks are required for kids and students in Kinder and up; lower elementary ages will be allowed to take masks off once they are settled in their small group rooms

Low-Touch

- The building will not be opened to full capacity. By limiting registration for adult worship, our Next Gen areas will naturally have fewer Sunday morning attendees. Events throughout the week will be hosted in spaces that ensure social distancing is feasible.
- Our experience will be as “low touch” as possible. When it comes to working with kids and students, social distancing is a challenge, which is why masks are so important for our environments during small group, large group, and pre/post service moments.
- Please send only one parent into TrailKids for drop-off and pick-up.
- Frisco Campus Soft Play area is closed at this time.
- All food/snack items will be pre-packaged, individual servings.
- You’ll see lots of big waves, but let’s avoid hugs, high-fives and handshakes.

Temperature Checks

- Every staff member, volunteer and child in Next Gen will have their temperature taken before checking in. We aren’t able to check in anyone with a temperature of 100.4 or higher.

We’ll all need to work together to keep our kids and students safe, so please stay home and participate online if your child:

- Has had a fever in the past 14 days
- Shows any symptoms of COVID-19
- Has been around anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19
