



FAQ

1. What is Rooted?

Rooted is a 10-week discipleship program and a catalyst for life-change. It provokes questions, conversations and group experiences designed to give you a glimpse of *your* story in God's story.

2. How will I register and what is the cost?

Once registration is open for the upcoming session, choose your session time and follow the steps. The cost for the course is \$25 per person, which includes all sessions, your workbook and other materials, and the Celebration dinner at the end of the 10 weeks.

3. Is there childcare?

Frisco Campus Groups: Limited childcare is available on a first come, first served basis for \$35 per child, per semester. You can register for KidCare at the same time you register for Rooted.

McKinney Campus Groups: No childcare is available. We offer KidCare reimbursement to offset babysitting costs. Learn more [here](#).

4. Where will my Rooted group meet?

Frisco Groups: All of our Frisco Rooted groups meet in different rooms around our Frisco campus.



McKinney Groups: All of our McKinney Rooted groups meet in different rooms around our McKinney campus.

5. What if I can't make all ten weeks?

We understand that Rooted is a large time commitment, but we believe it's worth it to invest in the entire process. If you know you'll miss more than two meetings, we ask that you wait until the next session of Rooted. The 10 weeks are a cumulative experience, and so we ask that every participant commit to honor each other by being at every meeting.

6. How will the Rooted groups be chosen?

Our Rooted team prayerfully places participants into groups of 10 to 12 people. We group by age, marital status, life stage and area of town. We form married couples, women, men, co-ed and young adult groups. These groups ultimately depend upon the demographic of those who register.

A substantial amount of prayer and thoughtfulness goes into creating groups, which we think will provide the best experience for all participants. While we do our best to honor requests, we cannot guarantee that we will be able to accommodate all friend or leader requests.



7. What is the difference between Rooted and Small Groups?

Rooted is the on-ramp to Small Groups. Your Rooted group at the end of the 10 weeks becomes your Small Group, and we strongly advise that you go through Rooted before joining an open Small Group.

8. Are there scholarships available?

We believe that Rooted is a life-changing experience and we want everyone to participate! We understand that the Rooted registration fee may be a burden for some and we are happy to provide scholarships. To inquire email us at rooted@prestontrail.org

9. Can I facilitate a Rooted group?

10. What are the two off-site experiences and is KidCare provided for those?

Each group will have a Prayer Experience and a Serve Experience outside of regular group time. No on-site KidCare is provided for the experiences.

11. Will we meet the week of Spring Break? (Winter Semester Only)

No, there will be no Rooted groups meeting week of March 8.
