



May resource bags are now available in the Foyer for all families with children ages 2-12.



CLS Spring Musical



TODAY'S LIGHT offers daily readings and devotionals in a quarterly magazine that help you dig into God's Word.


"Get the Big Picture" sections give a helpful overview of the day's text before you read the passage.

"Sharpen the Focus" sections help you clearly understand the passage and see its meaning for your life.


"Zoom In" sections highlight interesting parts of the text you may not notice at first glance, and give practical suggestions for living according to God's Word daily.
