

Did you know Trinity is the only congregation printing the Braille scripture calendar? A team of five volunteers meets weekly for two hours producing the 2023 calendar. The theme for 2023 is "A Time for Everything" from Ecclesiastes 3. There are orders for 3400+ calendars, so our work is in demand. The team can print 90 calendars per week; it will take 38 weeks to print enough to fill the orders which will be mailed in late October or early November. Until then the calendars are stored in boxes at Trinity. Thanks to Bob Close, Terry Stuber and the late Pete Peterson for maintaining the machines. 
