Optional Opener:

What is the best letter you have ever received and why?

Questions:

- Revelation is a letter written to particular people who were facing severe troubles, persecutions, trials, and sufferings. What aspect of the gospel would be especially important amidst such circumstances?
- 2. In the opening greeting of John's letter to the churches in Asia, he shares seven descriptions of Jesus. Jesus is 1) the faithful witness; 2) the firstborn of the dead;
- 3) the ruler of kings on earth. 4) To him who loves us; 5) and has freed us from our sins by his blood; 6) and made us a kingdom, priests to his God and Father; 7) Behold, he is coming with the clouds.

Discuss what each of these seven descriptions mean?

- 3. The first action verb that describes Jesus is love (v 4). Why is it so important to know that he continuously loves us.
- 4. What does it mean to be a priest in God's kingdom? What do priests do? How could it change your life to know that you are already a priest in God's kingdom?
- 5. Jesus is described as, "he is coming with the clouds". This is a reference from Daniel 7:13. Please take some time to read Daniel 7 for background.
- 6. Revelation 1:7 may be the theme verse for the entire letter. Why is this verse so important?

Practical application:

- 7. If you were asked to tell someone three facts about Jesus that are especially significant to you, what would you say (refer to question #2 above)? Why are these facts so important to you?
- 8. Read Ephesians 3:14-19. Please pray this prayer for your group and for yourself.
