### Optional Opener:

If you could have any famous person you wanted join you for dinner, whom would you invite?

#### Questions:

- 1. What does the "faithful and true witness" say to the church in Laodicea (v 15)? What do you think he means? How does the Church assess itself (v 17)? Why the contrast?
- 2. Please read Job 23:10 and Proverbs 27:21. In Rev 3:18, what does Jesus tell the people of the church of Laodicea to do? What does this communicate about true wealth?
- 3. How does Jesus Christ describe his present relationship to the church in Laodicea (v 20)?
- 4. How would you describe Jesus Christ, based on what you have read so far in Revelation? How does this broaden your picture of Jesus in the Gospels?

### Practical Application:

- 5. How does this passage strike you where do you feel you are in terms of your spiritual life?
- 6. What area(s) of your life might Jesus be quietly, or loudly, knocking and desiring to come in? (See the attached picture.) What "rooms" is he patiently waiting to "come in and dine with you"—the "room" of your workplace, family, relationships, finances, past, future, dreams, emotions or fears?
