Optional Opener:

Around the house, are you more like a lion or a lamb? Why?

Questions:

1. What does John see in God's right hand? How does he describe this thing (v 1)? What do you think makes the scroll so significant?
2. What question does the mighty angel ask (v 2)? What dilemma does the sealed scroll pose (v 3)? What is John's reaction to this situation (v 4)?
3. What word of hope is addressed to John (v 5)?
4. When John looks up to behold the Lion, what does he see (v 6)? What do you think is the significance of this?
5. Analyze the three songs (vv 9-13): Who comprises each group (vv 8, 11, 13)? How is the Lamb described in each song?

Practical Application:

6. What would the visions in chapters 4 and 5 have meant to the persecuted Christians of Asia? What does this vision say to us today?
7. As a group, perhaps you can imagine what it would be like to hear the voice of many angels, numbering ten thousand times ten thousand (v 11). Can you imagine 100,000,000 people – roughly the population of the Philippines – singing together in a loud voice the song in verse 12? Take a minute and consider how awe-inspiring that expression of worship would be.

Before your next group gathering, see if you can capture this scene of praise via a sketch on a piece of paper or a written prayer, and show your work in your group next week.
