"The Vision of the 7 Seals"

Revelation 6-8:1

Optional Opener:

With what kind of horse do you most identify: Clydesdale? Thoroughbred? Mustang? Pony? Donkey? How so?

- 1. Who or what might each of the horse riders represent (6:1-8)? How so?
- 2. In what sense do the first three horse riders lead to the fourth?

How have these forces – conquest, strife, scarcity and death – operated throughout history? For example, what has happened historically in the wakes of powerful leaders when such a leader takes or re-takes control of a place and people? Is there usually agreement or resistance from that place and people?

- 3. What does the opening of the fifth seal reveal (6:9-11)? How is this related to the suffering or tribulation of the Christians in John's time?
- 4. What happens when the sixth seal is broken (6:12-17)?
- 5. What is the message of the fifth angel (7:2-3)? For background reference, see Genesis 4:15: Ezekiel 9:4-6: Ephesians 1:13-14.
- 6. Read 7:9-17 aloud, perhaps this time taking turns in the group. How do you describe what is happening in what John sees here?

Practical Application:

- 7. What seal makes the greatest impression on you and why?
- 8. What areas of life if any do you tend to "resist" God? How can you as a group help each other in these areas, to move toward "openness" to God?
- What is your greatest point of suffering or tribulation? How difficult does it now look after hearing and contemplating anew God's word in 7:9-17?
- 10. What challenge or opportunity might you be facing this upcoming week and how will you now, in light of this passage of Revelation, approach it any differently?
