Opener:

What have been the three greatest years of your life? Why?

Questions:

- 1. What is John given and what is he instructed to do (v 1)? What is the significance of this act John is called to perform?
- 2. What is John told about the outer court of the temple (v 2)?
- 3. In verse 3, what will be given to the two witnesses; consequently what will they do?
- 4. What will happen to these witnesses? What results from their death and resurrection?

Application:

- 5. What has been toughest or the most rewarding about living out your faith at work? At school? At home? Why?
- 6. How have you felt especially empowered by God in the last six months?
- 7. What do you learn in this passage about what it means to be a witness?

Responding in prayer:

For what should you like to receive prayer for, either from your group or from prayer ministers at the altar on Sundays? What might God want you to leave behind as we move into this new year, in order to empower you to reflect God's goodness to others in 2016.
