Openers:

If you could have a bowl full of anything right now, what would you want? Why?

Have you had any firsthand experience with a natural disaster and if so what do you remember most about it?

Questions:

1. Describe the scene John saw in 15:1, 5-7. What do you think is the significance of this?
2. What characteristic of God is emphasized in the song John heard sung by those who stood on the sea (15:2-4)?
3. Describe the first four plagues (16:2-4,8). What do you think these represent?
4. Describe the fifth plague (16:10-11). What do you think this one depicts?
5. Against whom are the plagues directed (16:2)? Who are spared from these plagues (15:2)? For reference, revisit 7:9,14.

Application:

6. What great act has God done in your life for which you praise him today? Did that involve a turn away from something in order to turn to him (repentance)?
7. As a disciple of Jesus, how do these passages make you feel? How has God surprised you through the Revelation sermon series?
8. Has your conviction of hope developed through the Revelation sermon series? If so, try to articulate how to your group.

How have your convictions of God moved you to practice your faith? How might these move you to action this week, in a small or not so small way?
