Opener:

Tell your group something radiant or good in this season of your life. Or, offer something for which you are grateful.

Questions:

1. How does John describe the "holy city" (21:10-11)?

What attributes of God do you see in these verses? Which are the most meaningful to you?

2. Whose names are on the gates of the city (21:12)? Whose names are on the foundations (21:14)? Discuss what you think is the significance of this?

3. Describe the scene John illuminates in 22:1-2. See Genesis 2:10; Psalm 46:4; Ezekiel 47:1; Zechariah 14:8. Discuss.

4. How are God's people described in 22:3? What blessings do they enjoy (22:4-5)?

Application:

5. What comfort and confidence do you find in the description of the city in 21:22-27?

6. Read Genesis 2:9 and 3:1-24. What do you observe regarding the tree of life in Eden and the holy city (22:1-5)?

7. Take some time to pray together as a group. As the Church now comes to the final passage of Revelation in its sermon series, ask God to open your eyes to him unlike they have ever been open before. As you move into the rest of this week, how can you be expectant of his answer to your prayers?
