We share the good news and pursue the advancement of God's Kingdom in our communities, our cities, and the nations.

- 1) In this week's sermon, Pastor Chad discussed the Puritan efforts to establish the kingdom of God in everything that they did. Is this possible in the 21st century? Why is it difficult to build kingdom values in our world?
- 2) In Genesis 12:1-3, God declares that He would use the people of Israel to be a blessing to all the families of the earth. What do you think this means? How do you think that they were supposed to accomplish this enormous task?
- 3) Read Isaiah 49:6. Israel was to be a light to nations (a "city on a hill" -Jesus' description in Matthew 5:14) who was to represent kingdom values while advancing the kingdom agenda. But according to the text they began "thinking too small, thinking only about themselves." In what ways is the modern church sometimes similar in its inward focus?
- 4) The verses listed below all speak of the people God used in the Old Testament to advance His kingdom agenda to the nations of the earth. When you look at this list, what does it tell you about God's outward focus and His interest in establishing His kingdom throughout the entire earth?




