- 3. Read Ephesians 1:17-23 aloud. Reread it another time. List the six things Paul prayed for the Ephesians. Then have some discussion about your biblical understanding of "wisdom," "revelation," and "enlightenment." How do these differ from "knowledge?"
- 4. Have you ever felt or believed you saw in someone else God providing an extraordinary measure of strength for a time or purpose? Or has God supplied you the strength to take the next step in the way you believe he is calling you in this season?
- 5. According to Eph 1:22-23, what position does Jesus have? In what sense does Jesus fill all in all? In what sense is the church the fullness of Christ?
