- 1) Read Galatians 1:6-9 together as a group. Describe Paul's tone in these verses. Why do you think he takes such a tone with this church that he recently planted?
- 2) What words does Paul use to warn the Galatian church about "other gospels"?
- 3) On Sunday, Pastor Chad said that Paul's reference to "distorted gospels" meant literally "to put what should be in front in back, and what should be in back in front." What are some distortions that you have personally seen to the gospel? What items were put in front?
- 4) Why do you think that people like to add or subtract from the gospel message in the Bible?
- 5) Read John 14:6 and Acts 4:12. What would you say to a person who believes that "all religions basically the same" or "If everyone does the best they can it will all work out for them in the end."
- 6) Read Acts 17:22-31 Does the Apostle Paul believe that all religions are basically the same? How does he respond to people who believe in other gods and religions? What examples can we use from the apostle Paul in how to share our faith graciously and respectfully with others who might have a different religious system?

7) On Sunday, Pastor Chad mentioned that humanism (the idea that more science and human achievement can save humanity) has become gospel for many. Read Jeremiah 17:9. What does this verse say about humanism?
