- 2) 1 Peter 1:15-16 speaks of God's perfect holiness. How would our sinfulness be an obstacle to our relationship with God when he is perfectly holy?
- 3) Read 1 John 3:4. What does this verse say about how God views any sin? Why does John use such strong language to describe sin?
- 4) Read Isaiah 59:2, Romans 6:23, Ephesians 2:1, and Ephesians 2:3. According to these verses, what has happened to us as a result of our sin? What do you think these verses mean? How would you describe humanity's condition?
- 5) Based upon all of the Bible verses provided above, what would you tell a person who believed that "being good" was enough to satisfy God?
- 6) Read 2 Corinthians 5:14-21. What solution does God provide for our sin and for our judgment?
