- 4) What should "one another-ness" look like or act like to gain the attention of the world around us?
- 5) Read 1 John 3:16-23. Discuss what John says we should do to show our love for one another? Why do you think churches struggle with some of these?
- 6) Pastor Chad mentioned that although Lucian was an antagonist of Christianity in the 2nd century, he was still amazed at how Christians treated each other. Lucian said, "It is incredible to see the fervor with which the people of that religion help each other in their wants. They spare nothing. Their first legislator [Jesus] has put it into their heads that they are brethren."
