- 3) Read 1 Corinthians 12:12-27. What metaphor does Paul use to describe the Church? What is Paul trying to convey by using this imagery?
- 4) Reread 1 Corinthians 12:15,16,21. What point is Paul trying to make? What causes us to value some parts of the body more than others and think lesser of other parts?
- 5) Give practical examples of how everyone participating and serving in the Body of Christ is important for advancing the Kingdom of God.
- 6) Talk about how you might be able to use your gifts in the Body of Christ to advance the Kingdom of God.
