### FAQs & Requirements

How do I prepare for worship?

- If you are vulnerable, please stay at home.
- Wear a facemask as you enter the Worship Center.
- If you are sick (fever, cough, runny nose) you are required to stay at home.
- If you have COVID or been in contact with someone who has it, you are required to stay at home.
- Reserve your spot in worship at [www.mabc.church/rsvp](http://www.mabc.church/rsvp).

How are we preparing the facility?

- High touch surfaces and bathrooms will be sanitized before each service.
- Signs encouraging healthy habits will be posted.
- There will be clear entrances and exits into the building and the worship center (like at the grocery store).
- Social distancing signage will be marked in “waiting” areas.

When do I worship?

- There will be multiple services available on the weekend.
- Online worship will always be available.
- We will have a special 8 AM service & worship style for Seniors only on Sunday mornings.

What should I expect?

- Please enter in designated entrances that are clearly marked and have the doors propped open.
- Greeters will welcome you with a friendly wave.
- You are encouraged to bring your own hand sanitizer but hand sanitizer stations will be available.
- We will not be passing out bulletins.
- Volunteers will be wearing masks.
- The worship team will be reduced due to social distancing; there will not be a choir or orchestra.
- You will be dismissed at the end of the service to decrease congregating and encouraged to use the designated exits.
- Please do not congregate in the facility.

Where do I sit in the Worship Center?

- There will be clearly marked spots.
- Families are encouraged to sit together.
- You are encouraged to give online or to utilize offering collection boxes .
- Baptism and the Lord's Supper will be delayed until a later phase.

What are we taking a temporary break from?

- Greeting time during the worship service.
- Baptism.
- Lord's Supper.
- Kids Worship.
- Bulletins and other handouts.

What about my kids?

- Kids of all ages will worship with their parents until a later phase.
- We will be passing out materials for kids (crayons & activity sheets) in individual packets.
- Activity sheets will be created and emailed to you on Thursday. They will also be available at [www.mabc.church/parenting](http://www.mabc.church/parenting).

What about my small group?

- Your small group will continue to meet via Zoom.
- We will resume small groups when all small groups (including preschool, children, and students) are able to meet together again.

Is it okay to stay at home?

- Yes! You are encouraged to worship online from home and participate in small groups via Zoom until you are comfortable joining the regathering of the church.

How can I help?

- We need volunteers who are willing to wear a mask for the safety of others.
- We need additional greeters, especially from younger generations, who are willing to greet via a kind word and a wave.
- We need ushers who will transition from collecting the offering to acting as guides to help find seating and to open the exit doors as needed.
- We need people to help sanitize the Worship Center and bathrooms between services.
