Bible Lesson Plan For Sunday, June 13, 2021 God the Holy Spirit

by Rev. Ralph Taylor

God, the Holy Spirit

Joel 2:28-30; Acts 2:1-4; Matthew 3:10-12; John 14:16-19; Acts 1:7, 8

- L. God, the Holy Spirit: His Coming Fulfilled (Acts 2:1-4)
- A. The Sixth Dispensation: The Church (Acts 2:1-4)
- 1. Clearly prophesied by our Lord (Matthew 16:13-20), the sending of the Holy Spirit ushered in the Church age. The Church: a spiritual organism consisting of those who have the indwelling presence of the Spirit of God. The Holy Spirit compares it to the human body, consisting of many members, of which Jesus Christ is the Head (1 Corinthians 12:12, 13; Colossians 2:19).
- God, the Holy Spirit, is in this age setting apart from the groups of Jews and Gentiles, a people for His name (Acts 15:14).
- 3. This ongoing process (sanctification) will be completed at the rapture of the Church, prior to the Lord's coming in judgment (1 Thessalonians 4:13-18; 2 Thessalonians 2:1-12)
- 4. Those who are baptized into the body of Christ are those who are of the *elect*, chosen by God before the establishment of time and space (Deuteronomy 7:6; 1 Peter 1:2) Compare John 6:44 and John 14:6
- B. This was not a fulfillment of Joel's prophecy but "...an illustration of what was taking place in Peter's day and as a guarantee that God would yet completely fulfill all that Joel had prophesied. The time of that fulfillment is stated here ('afterward'), i.e., in the latter days when Israel turns to the Lord." The New Scofield Reference Bible (See Revelation 6:12)
- 1. "...like a rushing, mighty wind..."; not wind, but like wind (experienced with their ears); John 3:8; the unseen Spirit at work in the lives of believers
- "...tongues as of fire..."; not fire, but like fire (experienced with their eyes);
 Malachi 3:1-3; the refining work of the Spirit
- "...began to speak with other tongues..." (they spoke in foreign languages which they did not know). Contrast this blessing of Pentecost with the curse of Genesis 8.
- II. God, the Holy Spirit, as Cleanser (Matthew 3:10-12)
- A. The coming judgment is imminent and final
- B. While there are outward signs of repentance, true repentance begins on the inside
- C. Those who do not repent shall not see God
- III. God, the Holy Spirit as, Comforter (John 14:16-19)
- A. As Spirit, He is omnipresent and is able to abide with each and every one of His own
- B. The world cannot receive Him because the world walks by sight and therefore cannot believe that He is, i.e., that He exists; for that reason they beg for visible signs and observable miracles.
- 1. 1 Corinthians 1:14-25
- 2. 1 Corinthians 2:14-16
- IV. God, the Holy Spirit Compels (Acts 1:7, 8)
- A. He compels us to spread the good news; "...like a burning fire shut up in my bones... and I could not refrain." See Jeremiah 20:7-9
- B. He gives us the power (courage) to spread the good news
- "Within the one Being, Who is God, there exist eternally (3) co-equal and co-eternal Persons, namely, the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit." James P. Waight
