# National Breast Cancer Awareness Month

Every October, the nation observes <u>National Breast</u> <u>Cancer Awareness Month</u>. Breast cancer is a disease that affects both women and men and is among the most common types of cancers

According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), breast cancer is the second most common cancer among women in the United States after skin cancer. About 1 in 8 women will get breast cancer during her life. Additionally, Black women die from breast cancer at a higher rate than white women.

While there is no way to completely prevent breast cancer, there are ways most women can <u>lower their risk</u> for the disease. Those include:

- Maintaining a healthy weight and exercising regularly.
- Eating a healthy diet.
- Limiting the use of alcohol.
- Breastfeeding, if possible.
