

Ladies Bible Study Questions for Week 5

James 2: 14-26

1. In verse 2:14, James speaks of a person having faith without deeds and asks, "Can such faith save him?" Can it? What's wrong with having faith without deeds?
2. Give a modern example of the situation described in verses James 2:15-16.
3. What is the point of 2:19 where James says that even the demons have faith?
4. Who are the two people in this chapter who are examples of real faith? How are they different? How are they similar? Look also at Hebrews 11:17 and Heb 11:31
5. Was Abraham saved by faith or works? After discussing this, look up Genesis 15:3-6, Romans 4:3.
6. Chronology is important when it comes to faith and works. Paul explains the sequence in Ephesians 2:8-10. What comes first and what comes second? Do you see a third step?
7. What exactly are good deeds or works? Look at Colossians 3:23 for one clue.
8. If you were to stand before a judge after being accused of being a Christian, what evidence would there be to convict you?
