HOW TO USE THIS READING GUIDE

This reading guide will take you through thirteen weeks of readings through the book of Exodus and related passages. The reading guide begins on Sunday, September 12th and ends on Saturday, December 4th. Start on this page to learn background and how to read through these books of the Bible and what verses you should memorize.

BACKGROUND AND HOW TO READ EXODUS

The Exodus event is one of the most consequential moments in human history. God's miraculous intervention in order to free his people from enslavement reshaped human history. Moreover, the events of the Exodus foreshadowed our exodus from slavery to sin because of the work of Christ. As you read the Book of Exodus, pay careful attention to gospel themes that are present throughout. Take note of the way this story foreshadows our story as God's people.

Additionally, God's raising up of Moses as the one who would deliver Israel is meant to foreshadow another deliverer, Jesus. As you read the story of Moses, write down ways that you see him foreshadow Jesus. Highlight parallels between Moses and Christ. It is in the Exodus that God prepares our hearts for the ultimate exodus out of bondage to sin and into a better kingdom with a better king.
